Reception Class

By now all children moving up to Reception Class in September will have received confirmation of their school place. Please can you let Nursery Staff which primary schools you have accepted so we can organise our transition meetings.

Ash End House Farm

This year we have organised a whole school trip to Ash End House Farm on **Monday 9th June**.

Due to high numbers and statutory minimum staff to child ratios, all children attending will need to be accompanied by a parent/carer.

You should by now have received a letter with further information. Please make sure that all permission slips and monies have been returned to nursery and that you have noted times and other relevant information received or ask nursery staff if you are unsure about anything.

The Play House is a participatory theatre programme, for nursery aged children, from Language Alive! The children will have the opportunity to work collaboratively with each other and the artists in a multi-sensory environment and retell the magical stories of "The Little Red Hen" and "Jack & the Beanstalk". The cost of these workshops will be met from the school budget.
